Economic Development

The Broken Arrow Economic Development Corporation strives to create wealth, jobs, and economic growth through the creation, attraction, and retention of business and talent in the community while facilitating innovation and creativity. BAEDC is a partnership of, and governed by, the business community, the municipality and education partners.





The BAEDC facilitated its second annual, award-winning Broken Arrow Blitz, expressing their collective appreciation for business investment both large and small. The BA Business Blitz,

which took place in October, was a holistic effort where the BAEDC, Chamber of Commerce, City of BA staff, volunteers, and officials visited 212 companies to thank them for their dedication, effort, investment, and contribution to the Broken Arrow area economy. The BAEDC was recognized with a Silver Award for last year's BA Blitz efforts at the International Economic Development Council annual conference.







The BAEDC continued their career awareness efforts for manufacturing but new for 2022 was expanding efforts to bring awareness to careers in the healthcare industry to students at Broken Arrow and Union Public Schools. During Healthcare Career Day on April 20, 2022 and Manufacturing Career Day on October 27, 2022, over 200 volunteers from local businesses were

able to connect with nearly 5,300 students at Broken Arrow and Union Freshman Academies, Broken Arrow Options Academy, and Union Alternative School. The day-long events are designed to break common misconceptions about careers in manufacturing and healthcare and spark an interest in students so we can continue the pipeline of talent in Broken Arrow.







Major Events



June 13th - 176 golfers

Held annually, the Broken Arrow Chamber Golf Tournament provides fun throughout the entire day with chances to win even if your golf game isn't the greatest. The tournament features a morning and afternoon flight and is a four-person scramble with a shotgun start. The golf tournament was hosted at the Club at Indian Springs and provided a perfect day for networking among our members.



July 16th – 5,349 attendees

Taste of Summer, our all-you-can-eat ice cream festival, presented by Blue Bell and 1-800 Water Damage is an annual summer tradition in Broken Arrow. The 2022 event greeted over 5,300 attendees despite a heat advisory! Attendees consumed 489 gallons of ice cream, which is about 12,225 scoops of ice cream in addition to more than 10,000 snack items! This event also features food trucks and local vendors. This event provides plenty of activities ranging from our vendor marketplace, to our get active zone, and water activity areas to keep cool!



February 5th - 518 attendees

The Annual Gala is a black-tie event where the Arrowhead Business Award winners are announced and several community leaders are celebrated for their contributions to Broken Arrow. The Annual Gala is held at Stoney Creek Hotel and Conference Center. This year's event boasted a Masquerade theme and a rocking after-party with entertainment provided by The Get Down Band. Ninety-eight different businesses were represented at the 2022 event where sixteen major awards were given.



June 9th- 12th - 25,917 attendees


Rooster Days is a proud Broken Arrow tradition and in 2022, it celebrated its 91st Anniversary, making it the longest-running festival in Oklahoma. The festival takes place at Central Park on Main Street each year. There is something for everyone at Rooster Days, including live entertainment, a parade on Main Street, Miss Rooster Days Pageant, carnival food, carnival rides, cornhole tournament, Rooster Days Run, and our ever-expanding marketplace. The people of Broken Arrow will see their beloved festival return to its traditional May dates in 2023!





October 6th - 352 attendees

This event has quickly become the most sought-after table in Broken Arrow. This event sold out at 44 tables and 352 attendees in 2022 and is already sold out for 2023! The Main Street Burn Cigar Dinner is held outside at the Rose District Plaza and includes a steak dinner, a full bar, and a wonderful, handpicked selection of cigars. This evening, full of networking, also boasts a live and silent auction filled with items like AR-15s, golf packages, trips, and so much more.



December 1st - 634 attendees

The Broken Arrow Wine Walk is a fun night of wine tasting, food and shopping in the Rose District. Rose District retailers and restaurants transform into wine tasting locations for the evening. It is the perfect way to knock out holiday shopping while having fun and sampling some delicious wines and great food in Broken Arrow's historic arts and entertainment district. New to the event this year was a block party, where Commercial Street was blocked for a stage with live music and additional vendors, creating the perfect holiday shopping atmosphere. This year we sold out at 600 tickets (170 more than 2020, and the most in the event's history).



December 17th – 87 participating merchants

Buy Broken Arrow is our shop local campaign that encourages shopping in Broken arrow during the holiday season. The campaign gives away a total of \$16,000 in cash and prizes, which includes a \$10,000, \$3,000, and \$2,000 cash awards. New this year was our \$1,000 Small Business sponsor Drawing. 2022 boasted more than 87 participating merchants who handed out more than 1.5 million tickets!



















Businesses are busy working on growing their companies. They often do not have the time to stay abreast of the rapidly changing legislative environment or really understand the impact it may have on them daily.

The Broken Arrow Chamber strives to be the leading voice to and for Broken Arrow businesses on legislative issues and advocate to ensure a pro-growth business environment. In 2022, we created a legislative agenda that represented the top issues we believed would impact our business climate going into the 2023 Legislative session.

Issues for the 2022 agenda were identified by the Broken Arrow Business Advocacy Council through membership feedback, city leadership, educational partners, and our strategic partners including the U.S. Chamber of Commerce, Tulsa Regional OneVoice Agenda as well as the Oklahoma State Chamber of Commerce.

SUPPORTED BILLS IN 2022



HB 3688 - Expands Definition to Include Custom-Order Manufacturing

Expands the definition of manufacturing and the manufacturing sales tax exemption to any manufacturer engaged in customorder manufacturing. It greatly benefits Broken Arrow manufacturers.



HB 4196 - Needed Oklahoma Workers Act

Establishes a revolving fund for State Regents to distribute funds to students in three critical occupations: nursing, engineering, and teaching. Funds are to be distributed equally between the three occupations and divided amongst state colleges and universities on a per-student basis. These are high-demand occupations in Broken Arrow.



SB 1481 - Elimination of Corporate Franchise Tax

Proposes the elimination of the levy of the Oklahoma franchise tax effective for the tax year 2023. Forecasted a decrease in franchise tax collections of \$57.2 million. Assists in continuing to attract new business growth in Oklahoma.



SB 1718 - Medical Marijuana Growers License Freeze

Places a moratorium on approving commercial grower licenses until OMMA conducts an inspection and financial audit of all current licensees and their operations. There is no timeline indicated for the moratorium.



SB 1461 - Oklahoma Air Service Development Grant Program

Creates a revolving fund and program to provide financial assistance to attract commercial air service, specifically new routes. Can be utilized for the marketing, research, and attraction of much-needed new air service. Assists in the attraction of new business to Oklahoma.





































